Proclamation 5761 (Excerpts)

In the 15 years since the Supreme Court's decision in Roe v. Wade, America's unborn have been denied their right to life. Among the tragic and unspeakable results...have been the loss of life of 22 million infants before birth; the pressure and anguish of countless women and girls who are driven to abortion; and a cheapening of our respect for the human person and the sanctity of human life.

We are told that we may not interfere with abortion. We are told that we may not "impose our morality". We are told as well that there exists a "right" to end the lives of unborn children; yet no one can explain how such a right can exist in stark contradiction of each person's fundamental right to life. That right to life belongs equally to babies in the womb, babies born handicapped, and the elderly or infirm... The unalienable right to life is found not only in the Declaration of Independence but also in the Constitution that **every President is sworn to preserve, protect, and defend.**
